Join us for a day trip to RMNP for a tour program led by park service rangers. Travel deep inside the park to glacial lakes nestled between the parks most beautiful & famous peaks. Snowshoe from Bear Lake up to Nymph & Dream Lakes and enjoy the wonders of the park while learning about its ecology. Discover how animals survive winter and learn the skills you need to stay warm and safe while exploring outdoors during the winter.

So... what do you need to bring?

A daypack to carry your ten essentials plus snack, lunch, and water bottle, (canteen or hydro pack optional) Maintain comfort throughout the day by wearing layered clothing and outerwear (e.g.; long johns, fleece, wind & water resistant shell. Please no blue jeans) You'll also need warm (insulated) boots, gloves, wool cap, sunglasses, sunscreen, and bring along a winter coat and snow pants if extreme weather conditions prevail. Be sure to eat a good breakfast at home, you'll need it for the energy and it will help us to avoid unnecessary stops along the way. We are expecting to arrive at the Parks east entrance by 9:30am to meet with a ranger.
